



Barry County 4-H Goat Project Notebook

Requirements

- “About your Goat” paperwork is no longer a required element of the record book.
- Place all items in order in a 3 ring binder which can be decorated as the member chooses.
- Notebook is to include all years records with the current year on the top, which must be carried forward each year.
- Do your own work, use your own words.
- Neatness Counts, the content needs to be neat, legible, orderly, with an appealing overall general appearance.
- Don’t use subject matter more than once.

Notebook guidelines

Notebooks will be judged on the following guidelines in addition to the age appropriateness of the content.

- Table of Contents
 - Members Name
 - Members Age
 - Number of years in the goat project
 - Number of years in 4-H
- Personal 4-H Story about you and your goat(S) with photos, updated yearly
- Include Pictures of you and your goat(s).
- Every year members pick 1 breed and write about characteristics, size, descriptions, origin, disqualifications, use, photo’s, etc
- Every year pick 1 disease/ailment/condition/health issue not previously used before.
- In addition to the requirements above, participants need to research topics from the list below, based on their age (depth of research should increase with age and should not be cut & pasted/copied from source) as follows:
 - Age 9-11; research one topic.

- 12-14; research two topics.
- 15 and up; research three topics.
