Michigan Rabbit/Cavy 4-H Scholarship - Award amount: Varies, two to four given annually. *Who can apply:* Those who will be college freshmen in Fall 2014. Students must have been enrolled in a 4-H rabbit or cavy project for at least three years and have financial need.
Michigan State University 4-H Scholarships - Award amount: \$2,500 annually for four consecutive years of full-time study at MSU. Six scholarships are given annually. *Who can apply:* 4-H members who are high school seniors must apply to MSU and submit the MSU 4-H Scholarship Application by November 1 of their senior year. Applicants must meet the standard admissions requirements of the university and be accepted to MSU.
