Instructions for ON LINE PQA+ Training and Certification

Starting in March, Michigan youth will be able to access an on-line PQA+ tutorial. Michigan will be the first state to have access to the on-line program. Please read the directions below carefully.

- 1. Youth MUST do the on-line training and testing at least one month prior to their PQA+ number expiring. This will ensure that you get a current number in a timely fashion.
- Each youth that registers with the system must provide a unique email address for the system to complete registration. This means that each family member must have their own email address or utilize a parent's/responsible adult's email. Once an email has been used in the system, It cannot be repeated for another youth.
- 3. Contact the Pork Check off Service Center by calling **(800) 456-7675**. This is a toll free number. Representatives at the service center will then proceed to register the youth for the online PQA Plus program. It may take the system **up to 3 days** to update the registration.
- 4. Once the registration is completed and the database is updated, an email will be sent to the youth with instructions on how to enter the online system.
- 5. Once the youth has entered the online system, they will need to complete an on-line training module. If the youth leaves the training module at any time, they can later return where they left off and finish the module.
- 6. Once the training module is completed, if the youth is eligible to test out they will be prompted to do so. Once a test is started, it must be completed at that time.
- 7. The system will update the database and the youth will be able to print their PQA Plus number and expiration date. It may take up to a week for the system to update after the online program is completed.
- 8. Certified Youth PQA Plus Advisors will be able to search the system to find current information for youth.

Things to Remember

- This is a pilot program, and there may be a few glitches. Be patient.
- If you skip the face to face trainings, and don't do the online training, you may not be able to sell your hogs.
- If you procrastinate and don't get the on-line training done at least one month before the sale, you may not be able to sell your hogs.
