Michigan 4-H Scholarships

Michigan State University 4-H Scholarship

Who can apply: 4-H members who are high school seniors must apply to MSU and submit the MSU 4-H Scholarship Application by November 1 of their senior year. Applicants must meet the standard admissions requirements of the university and be accepted to MSU. Award amount: \$2,500 annually for four consecutive years of full-time study at MSU. Six scholarships are given annually. Preference to participation in 4-H precollege programs and other state events is given.

Michigan State University Pre-College Program Scholarship

Who can apply: Students in 8th, 9th or 10th grade following their MSU pre-college program involvement (such as 4-H Exploration Days, 4-H Great Lakes & Natural Resources Camp, 4-H Discovery Camp, or 4-H Capitol Experience). Students will be invited to apply by their county MSU Extension 4-H staff for Exploration Days or the pre-college program director for GLNR Camp, Discovery Camp and Capitol Experience.

Award amount: \$2,000 applied toward the student's first year at MSU as a degree-seeking student. Scholarship recipients are not guaranteed admission to MSU and must meet admission requirements upon submitting the MSU application as an incoming undergraduate.

Michigan Rabbit/Cavy 4-H Scholarship

Who can apply: Those who will be college freshmen in Fall 2013. Students must have been enrolled in a 4-H rabbit or cavy project for at least three years and have financial need. *Award amount:* Varies, two to four given annually.
