Join us for a 6 week online introductory course on Smart Veggie Gardening.

What: We will cover all aspects from what you will need to get started, the planning and preparation, plants to select, types of gardening, garden maintenance, including soil preparation, starting with and maintaining healthy plants, and various gardening activities.
